## Happy China to replace Pao Lim

Happy China to open: A new restaurant, Happy China Sushi & Bar, is slated to open Tuesday at 2505 Durham-Chapel Hill Blvd.

Min Zhu, the business co-owner, said the restaurant and bar will be a fine dining venue, serving American-style Chinese food with items priced at around \$10 to \$15. She said the restaurant will also offer sushi as well as beer, wine and mixed beverages.

The restaurant location previously housed Pao Lim Asian Bistro. She said it was a Chinese restaurant and later became a sushi and steak eatery. The previous owners closed their business in the location several months ago in order to retire, she said.

Happy China Sushi & Bar will be open from 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. on Friday and Saturday. For more information, call 919-237-2021.

**New McAlister's:** A new McAlister's Deli location is targeted to open Aug. 8 at 6807 Fayetteville Road.

The restaurant is the first of three new McAlister's locations that are planned for the Raleigh-Durham market, according to a news release.

The owner of the Fayetteville Road location is Casey Fish, 37, who is the CEO of a restaurant management group called ACI Holdings that owns and operates six Buffalo Wild Wings franchise locations in Virginia and South Carolina.

The McAlister's restaurant is a franchised location of the Ridgeland, Miss.-based McAlister's Corp. The restaurant chain's menu includes traditional sandwiches, paninis, spuds, soups, salads and desserts.
